DR OMER EL NAGIEB

Dr El Nagieb is an accredited specialist in Occupational Medicine with over 20 years of experience. He has served as Chief Medical Officer leading the Occupational Health (OH) service for the London Fire Brigade, established modern OH services for the oil and gas industry in Abu Dhabi, and was an Honorary Lecturer in Occupational Medicine at the University of Manchester. Dr El Nagieb returned back to the UK to lead the OH service for the London Fire Brigade - as the Chief Medical Officer. He worked with colleagues to revise the fitness standards for recruitment and retention to in the fire and rescue services in the UK.

Dr El Nagieb was appointed as the Federal Minister of Health for the Sudan and remained in the job until November 2021. During the tenure of his role he worked with colleagues and international health partners to rebuild the health system and promote and expand OH in the Sudan and the region.

Dr El Nagieb; with colleagues has founded the Centre of Occupational and Environmental Health – Africa to continue the ambitious program of expanding OH in the continent and beyond.



DR MARTIN HOGAN

Dr Martin Hogan is a full-time Occupational Physician since 1994 working full time in industry. He is the Managing Director of CHIPAM in Cork and a founding Partner of Corporate Health Ireland (CHI).
